

Cameron Park Corvette Club By- Laws

ARTICLE -1-

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the association of the Cameron Park Corvette Club, a car club, is to provide and promote an environment of fun, activities, charitable events (by donating time and showing our cars) and to encourage appreciation in automobile heritage.

ARTICLE -2-

ARTICLE -3-

ORGANIZATION

GOVERNMENT:

The Cameron Park Corvette Club shall be governed by a Board of Directors elected by a majority vote of all members, in good standing, who must be present at that meeting. That meeting shall be the second Tuesday of November each year. A member in good standing is defined as one who has paid their dues for the current year.

The nominations for the Board of Directors will occur on the second Tuesday of October each year at the regular meeting. Voting will occur on the second Tuesday of November with the members present at that meeting. Notice of the pending election will be sent out to all CPCC members in the October minutes and that will serve as notice of the November election.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, the Board shall be made up of a President, Vice President/Event Coordinator, Secretary, Treasurer, Webmaster.
- RESOLVED that, the term for each Board Member shall be one year, which will run with the calendar year. Reelection of said Members is permitted.
- RESOLVED that, should a Board Member need or request to be relieved of their position the request will be honored without question. At the next regular meeting there will be a request for nomination to fill that vacancy for the remainder of the year.
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- RESOLVED that, an Honorary Historian/ Photographer will maintain a chronological scrapbook of the Club's history and events.
- RESOLVED that the CPCC Treasurer shall file the yearly taxes with the IRS and update the State as necessary.

FINANCIALS:

The Cameron Park Corvette Club shall maintain a checking account that will be used for the operation and preservation of the Club.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, the Club shall pay a monthly account maintenance fee as required by the financial institution where the account is held.
- RESOLVED that, the Treasurer, keeping the best interests of the Club in mind, shall determine the financial institution where the account is held.

- RESOLVED that, the account shall require (1) signatures on checks for payment. Treasurer, President or Vice President
- RESOLVED that, the (1) required signatures shall be any of the three current Board Members that are signers on the checking account. Change of Board Members will require updating of the financial institutions signature card and will supersede all previous cards.
- RESOLVED that, a receipt must accompany authorized reimbursable expenditures paid by members. A signatory on the checking account must verify repayment.
- RESOLVED that, the Club shall provide necessary funds (\$250.00) for general operational expenses such as office supplies and website maintenance.

MEETINGS:

There shall be monthly meetings of the Cameron Park Corvette Club.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, meetings will be held on the Second Tuesday of every month at 6:30 PM. Check website for time and location.
- RESOLVED that, the next regular meeting site shall be determined at the current meeting before adjournment.
- RESOLVED that, at the discretion of the President the meeting date and site can be held before, during or after an event or activity.
- RESOLVED that, any issue or proposed change brought up at a meeting will be discussed and tabled until the next regular meeting and voted on.

DUES AND FEES:

The Cameron Park Corvette Club for the operation and preservation of the Club shall collect dues and fees.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, running with the calendar year there shall be annual dues payable with each Membership Application. Said dues shall be Forty dollars (\$40.00) per couple, Twenty dollars (\$20.00) per single.
- If a person joins after June 30th the dues will be (\$20.00) per couple and (\$10.00) for singles.
- RESOLVED that, Membership dues are due on NOVEMBER 1st and considered delinquent on NOVEMBER 31st . If not paid by that date, said member and will no longer be a member in good standing and on January 1st will be removed from the CPCC Roster.

ARTICLE -4-

QUALIFICATION

VEHICLES:

The Cameron Park Corvette Club welcomes all years of Corvettes without exception. **If a CPCC member sells his/her Corvette it must be replaced with another Corvette within six months to maintain their CPCC voting rights. At the end of 6 months if the car has not been replaced the active member shall be given the Associate Member status with no voting privileges and may not hold any office until they have purchased another Corvette.**

MEMBERSHIP:

Guidelines shall govern the qualifications of Members desired by the Cameron Park Corvette Club.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- **RESOLVED that, Members must be twenty-one (21) years of age unless sponsored by a family member and then that person has to be 18 years of age to qualifying for club membership.**
- RESOLVED that, Members must possess a valid California Drivers License.

- RESOLVED that, Members must maintain automobile insurance at all times as required by law.
- RESOLVED that, Members and their guests must display responsibility and safety with their vehicle at all times. Respect of other vehicles is Mandatory.
- RESOLVED that, no Member or their guest(s) will hold the Cameron Park Corvette Club responsible for any liability connected with Events, Activities or Meetings related to the Club.
- RESOLVED that, upon enrollment in the Club each Member will receive from the Treasurer a copy of these By-Laws and a Membership Roster.
- RESOLVED that, in paying the annual dues the Member accepts all the above listed Conditions of Membership.

PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY AND CONDUCT:

Guidelines shall govern the continued Membership in the Cameron Park Corvette Club.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, any Member or Members that do not maintain personal self-discipline and conduct themselves in a appropriate and socially accepted manner, WITHOUT EXCEPTION, will have their membership permanently revoked/terminated.
- RESOLVED that, the decision of what constitutes appropriate and inappropriate behavior rests with the Board of Directors. Their majority vote will determine Membership Status and their decision deemed final with no possibility of appeal.

ARTICLE -5-

AMENDMENTS:

The Board and Members of the Cameron Park Corvette Club reserve the right to amend, add and/or delete Articles or Sub-Articles.

The following resolutions are set forth, as follows:

- RESOLVED that, amendments, additions and/ or deletions will be made effective by the Board of Directors and voted on by the majority of Members in good standing present at the next regularly scheduled meeting during which the changes are agreed upon.
- RESOLVED that, the Secretary will document and incorporate any and all changes to the By-Laws
